

Fiddle Leaf Fig Care Tips

Ficus lyrata



Origin: Western Africa

Height: 3-10 ft (90 cm - 3 m) indoors

Light: Bright indirect light year-round. Give your plant a quarter turn every week or so to expose all sides to light.

Water: Keep soil evenly moist. Drooping yellow leaves are a sign of overwatering.

Humidity: Average room humidity.

Temperature: Average room temperatures 60-75°F/16-24°C.

Soil: Any good potting mix.

Fertilizer: Feed 3 times a year during the growing season (spring-summer-fall) with a balanced liquid fertilizer diluted by half.

Propagation: Stem tip cuttings and air layering. Propagating large-leaf fig trees is not easy for the amateur to do at home. These trees are slow to root from either method.
